

Ramblewood Pool Association
Party Policy

To book a party, please call Jill Tanner @ 731-616-1501. Please book ALL parties at least one week in advance. In planning your party, we ask that you please remember that Ramblewood Pool is a member-owned facility. We cannot close the pool for parties. Parties are not to exceed 2 ½ hours and must be ended by 30 minutes of pool closing time. We have to limit the size and time of the parties in order for other families to enjoy their time at the pool.

1. All parties are to be booked at least one week before party date. Cost of the party is a \$50.00 non-refundable fee.
No parties are booked on the calendar & no parties are allowed until payment is received.
2. **All swimming non-member party guests are charged \$5 per person.** The maximum number of guests (swimming and non-swimming) is 30; this **includes parents of children**. Parking space is limited, so we suggest you let guests know that they are welcome to drop off party guests at the pool. **Non-swimming guests are limited to pavilion area only.** We have to reserve the pool chairs, etc. for our members.
3. Due to State mandates, **for parties with over 10 swimmers**, the **host is responsible for hiring an additional lifeguard**. The additional lifeguards are hired at \$20 each per hour. (11 swimmers = 1 extra lifeguard @ \$20/hour; 20 swimmers = 2 lifeguards @ \$20 each/hour)
4. Party hosts may decorate the pavilion area ONLY, and are responsible for cleaning up all decorations after party is complete. Party hosts must clean up any and all "messes" left by party guests. **Each party is allowed up to three (3) picnic tables in the pavilion area.** Grills may be used OUTSIDE the pavilion. You are responsible for clean-up. Please do not dispose of hot charcoal/ashes in our trash cans.
5. **DAMAGE TO POOL &/or PAVILION:** The host member(s) is responsible for replacement cost of any damage to pool or pavilion equipment; i.e., chairs, umbrella, diving board, etc.
6. Please remember that our lifeguard(s) are there to work and that they have state regulations they must follow. Please do not distract the lifeguard while he/she is on duty with excessive conversation, horseplay, or standing in the lifeguard area. Please inform your party guests of this policy, also.
7. **Before being allowed to enter the pool, party guests will be informed by the host lifeguard of the pool rules. YOU are responsible for your guests. Please make sure all swimming guests can swim.**

The Ramblewood Estates Recreation Association executive board reserves the right to end any party not following the regular pool rules, as well as those not adhering to the rules above.
